#### **Garden Committee September Report**

As the summer season progressed, we noticed an increase in visitors to the garden. Many residents brought their adult kids and grandchildren to see what is growing and we love it! Some comments we heard: "I didn't know artichokes grew like that", "Oh, this is how broccoli is grown!", "As a city girl, I'm fascinated to see vegetables and fruits growing naturally here." We are so glad to see the community enjoying the garden!

What is growing: Boxes 17 & 18 - have bell peppers (different varieties) including one labeled as a "hot pepper dragon roll". But do not let the name scare you away; it's quite mild, flavorful and perfect in a stir-fry! Box 19 – has herbs growing (basil, cilantro, Italian parsley, sage). You are welcome to pick herbs and peppers in these three boxes. Newly planted: zucchini, lettuce, corn, green beans, tomatoes, and spinach to name a few. These vegetables are

coming along nicely but are too early to pick. In a few weeks, watch out for harvests that we will put in a basket on

the picnic table in the garden.


